SYDNEY, 25 JANUARY 2018

Suspension of protected industrial action by employees of Sydney Trains and NSW Trains – industrial action is threatening to endanger the welfare of part of the population – industrial action is threatening to cause significant damage to the Australian economy or an important part of it.

- A. Pursuant to s.424 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* (the Act), the Fair Work Commission orders that protected industrial action in relation to the proposed enterprise agreements be suspended until 6:00 pm on 8 March 2018.
- B. This order is binding on:
 - i. Sydney Trains;
 - ii. NSW Trains;
 - iii. Australia, Rail, Tram and Bus Industry Union (RTBU);
 - iv. Association of Professional Engineers, Scientists and Managers Australia (APESMA);
 - v. All employees of Sydney Trains and NSW Trains who are members of the RTBU and APESMA and who will be covered by the proposed enterprise agreements.
- C. This order comes into operation at 6:00 pm on 25 January 2018.
